Thank you for the opportunity to submit a comment on the Scheduled Premises Regulations Review.

In relation to Knackery's they need to be on a sufficient land mass to be able to have adequate area for suitable effluent & waste management systems, without any chance of contamination or run off entering adjacent property or local waterways.

The property must have its own water source on site to maintain the high levels of hygiene required to omit any chance of odour into the surrounding environment.

The topography and size of the land must be suitable to have a minimum 2 stage effluent pond management system. There must be absolutely no risk of any waste entering local waterways.

Any irrigation from the effluent ponds must not enter any other property or contaminate local waterways.
